

# Enlisted Sailors and Marines: USNA Awaits You

Enlisted personnel looking for an opportunity to enhance their education, increase skills and receive a commission in the U.S. Navy or Marine Corps, the U.S. Naval Academy (USNA) may be for you.

USNA in Annapolis, Md., offers an outstanding opportunity for qualified enlisted members of the Regular Navy, Naval Reserve and Marine Corps to embark on careers as officers in the Navy or Marine Corps. Students are designated midshipmen, U.S. Navy, receiving the pay of a midshipman, plus tuition, room and board. Upon graduation, they receive a Bachelor of Science degree and a commission in the Navy or Marine Corps Reserve.

USNA offers 18 academic majors in engineering, science, mathematics, social sciences and the humanities. In addition to the academic curriculum, students also take military professional courses in navigation, naval engineering, weapons, leadership, naval history and law.

The SECNAV may nominate up to 170 Regular and Reserve enlisted personnel each for appointments to the Naval Academy each year. Application packages will not be reviewed without the commanding officer's recommendation.

Application procedures and eligibility requirements are outlined in OPNAVINST 1420.1. Applicants must submit an online application at the following Web site:
