

Overnight Success

Commands can help accelerate how fast Sailors are notified of their performance on advancement exams by taking advantage of overnight delivery.


Sending answer sheets as soon as possible after an exam via overnight delivery to Naval Education and Training Professional Development and Technology Center (NETPDTC) helps ensure Sailors' answer sheets are scored promptly.

The goal is to streamline the process, while preserving the integrity of the advancement exam system. Commands are authorized to submit a separate letter of destruction, but a letter of transmittal is still required with the answer sheets.

Commands should monitor the electronic tote board located at www.advancement.cnet.navy.mil to verify that answer sheets have been received. If commands do not see their answer sheets listed on the tote board by the fifth working day after shipping (when shipped overnight), call NETPDTC at 1-850-452-1252 or DSN 922-1252 for assistance in tracking them.
