

MYPAY To Offer Service Members W-2s in January

Service members, retirees and annuitants will be able to check account statements and tax information online due to the new capabilities of the Defense Finance and Accounting Service's myPay system.

Active-duty and Reserve service members can now view and print their current year W-2, plus up to four years' prior W-2s.

Retirees can view and print their Retiree Account Statement. Annuitants can view and print their Annuitant Account Statement, 1099R tax statements, 1042S tax statements, and print and submit copies of the Report of Existence and Certificate of Eligibility forms.

MyPay users can also:

- View, print and save leave and earnings statements
- View and print tax statements
- Change federal and state tax withholdings
- Update bank account/ electronic transfer information
- Manage allotments
- Edit address information
- Purchase U.S. Savings Bonds
- Control Thrift Savings Plan enrollment (military)
- View and print travel vouchers (features vary by individual's service and status)

Use your Social Security number and PIN to log on at <https://mypay.dfas.mil> (old E/MSS PINs also work). Directions for obtaining new PINs are in the Frequently Asked Questions section of the Web site.
