

Selective Reenlistment Bonus Award Levels Revised


The Navy recently announced revised selective reenlistment bonuses (SRBs) that will further improve the skill mix in the fleet by targeting specific Navy enlisted classifications (NEC).

The SRB program creates incentives for Sailors to reenlist in targeted NECs or ratings. Coupled with Perform to Serve and other force shaping initiatives, these bonuses help the Navy retain Sailors with critical skills.

One hundred-twenty targeted NEC categories see an increase in SRB with this update. Forty NEC SRBs are reduced and 31 deleted. SRB for 15 rating categories are reduced, 17 are deleted and 13 are increased.

SRB award levels that increase will become effective June 23. Those decreasing will become effective July 23. Sailors may reenlist for SRB any time within the same fiscal year as their end of active obligated service.
