

NETC Announces Advanced Education Voucher Program For Senior Enlisted

The Naval Education and Training Command (NETC) recently released guidelines for a new program that is designed to provide advanced education opportunities for senior enlisted personnel.

The Advanced Education Voucher (AEV) Program is aimed at superior performers in paygrades E-7 to E-9 who have the potential for continued upward mobility, and specifically targets assistance for post secondary, Navy-relevant degree programs.

AEV for baccalaureate degree completion is capped at \$6,700 per year for a maximum of 36 months from the date of enrollment. Qualified candidates should have an associate's degree or the equivalent amount of college credit applicable to the degree being sought. There are 25 quota slots available for the FY05 selection board.



The AEV master's degree program covers 100 percent of tuition, books, and related fees up to a maximum of \$20,000 per year for up to 24 months of enrollment. Candidates must hold a baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution recognized by the Department of Education. Five quota slots are available through the FY05 selection board.

Deadline for applying for FY05 programs is March 10. Applications should be forwarded to the Naval Education and Training Professional Development and Technology Center (Code N2), 6490 Saufley Field Road, Pensacola, FL, 32509-5237.
