Federal Asian Pacific American Council Seeks Nominations

The Meritorious Service Award will be presented at the FAPAC National Leadership Training Conference, May 31–June 3, at the Crystal Gateway Marriott, Arlington, Va. The awardee must travel to Arlington during the week of May 31–June 3. Commands may provide funded orders (if available) to cover all expenses incident to conference attendance. Nominations must be received by April 21 (extended deadline), and nominees must have commanding officer's or officer-in-charge's signed endorsement letter.
