



NMAA Launches Online Survivor Benefits Resource

Sea service members can access personal government survivor benefit information via the 24/7 Survivor Benefits Analysis featured on the Navy Mutual Aid Association's (NMAA) Web site.

The Association has installed online calculators to provide personalized analysis of the benefits available from the Department of Defense, Department of Veterans Affairs and the Social Security Administration. To access these calculators, simply click on the "24/7 Survivor Benefits Analysis" button on NMAA's home page, www.navymutual.org.

The Survivor Entitlements and Benefits-At-A-Glance (SeaBAAG) Calculator provides an estimate of the benefits in place for a service member's family if they were to die in the line of duty. For service members who are assigned duties as a Casualty Assistance Calls Officer (CACO), the WebCACO Benefits Summary Calculator provides a benefits estimate for briefing a deceased service member's survivors on their benefits.
