DoD Launches Sexual Assault Prevention Web Site



Service members who are victims of sexual assault or who need information on the DoD policy on preventing sexual assaults can find the information at a new Web site.

The site, launched by Joint Task Force (JTF) Sexual Assault Prevention and Response, is a consolidated place to go to for information and has links to all the services' Web sites related to the sexual assault issue. It spells out what people can do if they are victims of sexual assault. The site may be used for the reporting of information as well as questions to answers asked by an individual.

If a commander or a first sergeant has questions, this site should provide the answers; but if not, they can send an e-mail and a Joint Task Force member will answer.
