




Electronic Training Jackets Help Sailors Manage Their Careers

The Electronic Training Jacket (ETJ) tool on the Navy Knowledge Online (NKO) Web site is an important link for Sailors who are tracking their career progression or preparing for advancement.

ETJ compiles data from a host of different sources for college degree and course data, service schools, College Level Entry Program (CLEP) exams, military courses (which provide American Council on Education (ACE) credits), language skills, additional qualification designations (AQDs), completed Corporate Enterprise and Training Activity Resource System (CeTARS) training information, and more. Ultimately, ETJ will be the definitive source for housing all of this information.



NKO provides the user various links to Navy database sites that are used for compiling the information contained in the ETJ. Step-by-step instructions are included for updating and correcting information in each folder of the Electronic Training Jacket.

If Sailors have problems getting their information updated, they should contact the local Personnel Support Activity (PSA), use the ETJ feedback link or ask for assistance via one of the many message boards on NKO.

Through NKO, Sailors can view and update their training jackets from any location with Internet access, 24-hours a day, seven days a week.
