



## Nominations Due for Federal Asian/Pacific American Council Meritorious Service Award

The Navy Equal Opportunity (EO) Office is seeking nominations for the Federal Asian/Pacific American Council (FAPAC) Meritorious Service Award. All packages are due by March 31.

The FAPAC Meritorious Service Award is awarded to a military member who has fostered an innovative and harmonious environment between the military and the Asian Pacific American (APA) civilian community and assisted the work force in overcoming discrimination and eliminating barriers that hinder equal opportunity for APAs and other minorities in the armed forces.



Nomination packets should include a cover or transmittal memorandum, FAPAC nomination form, narrative describing the nominee's accomplishments, citation summarizing the nominee's accomplishment for inclusion in the program brochure and a digital black and white or color photograph of the nominee.

The Department of Defense will observe National Asian American Heritage Month with FAPAC during their National Leadership Training Conference May 8-12 at the Hilton Hawaiian Village in Honolulu.
