## Safe Haven Extension Available for Hurricane Katrina Military Family Members

Dependents of Navy military personnel who were affected by Hurricane Katrina have been approved for extensions of their "Safe Haven" benefits until Aug. 1. Current Safe Haven and 100 percent per diem allowances expire April 17.

The forms required to request an extension of Safe Haven, move to a designated place, or to receive the 100 percent evacuation allowances are available through the chain of command or at the Navy Family Disaster Assistance Web site.

Assistance with any issues resulting from hurricane devastation is available through the Community Support Centers (CSC) 2005 hurricane season. Case managers from the CSC are available to assist any member of the Navy family which includes military members, Navy civilians, retirees, and dependents.
