## Naval Safety Center Finds Personal Data on Web Site

Personal information on more than 100,000 Navy and Marine Corps aviators and air crew was discovered and removed from the Naval Safety Center (NSC) Web site July 6.

The information was on the command's publicly available Web site, [www.safetycenter.navy.mil](http://www.safetycenter.navy.mil), and included full names and social security numbers. The information was also contained on 1,083 Web Enabled Safety System program disks mailed to Navy and Marine Corps commands.

NSC had the information removed and is taking steps to recall the disks.

The Navy is working quickly to notify affected individuals. Affected members include active and reserve members, as well as any aviator who may have served during the past 20 years. The command is in the process of sending letters to each affected person. The Navy Personnel Command call center in Millington, Tenn., is setting up a call center to be manned 24 hours a day to assist affected personnel. The call center will be available at 1-866-827-5672.
