Online Program Unveiled To Reduce Traffic Risks

The Travel Risk Planning System (TRiPS) is an online system that will help Sailors plan their travel, do a risk assessment of that trip, and receive automated suggestions to improve traffic safety.

TRiPS also offers a mapping product similar to the popular

Mapquest program, including a link that will inform Sailors of areas undergoing road construction.

Once the assessment is complete, the program will even print a leave form for the user. Links also exist for the driver's supervisor, who will sign off on the trip planner and can review the results of the risk assessment and suggested changes.
