Some of NPC's Fleetwide Administrative Functions Restored

The deputy director of the U.S. Navy's focal point for all personnel transactions said that Sailors concerned with reenlistments, advancements and other administrative functions should realize that precautions are being taken to ensure personal information is protected, administrative functions are being restored and the selection board process is put back in motion following the May 1 storm and flooding which devastated Naval Support Activity Mid-South.



The interruption in service came as a result of the May 1 storm and severe flooding which devastated Shelby county and caused significant structural damage to NSA Mid-South facilities and crippled the base's infrastructure. NPC is based at NSA Mid-South in Millington.

Although facilities hosting NPC functions suffered damage, the primary consideration has been toward ensuring Sailors, family members and civilians have received the aid they need. Nearly 2,000 people work at NPC, some of whom were impacted by the inclement weather.

The Reserve component sustained significant setbacks in performing personnel actions such as retirements, separations and other administrative functions for reservists Navywide. NPC Sailors within the department are working around the clock to ensure Reserve Sailors needs are being met.

NPC's primary concern right now is ensuring Sailors who have an administrative emergency – an unexpected transfer within a few days – receive service.
