

# FLEETRIDE/PTS Rules of Engagement

## Reporting Aboard

Beginning Fleet RIDE/PTS Engagement.

Submit request for a Reporting Career Development Board (CDB) to your CCC. Use Fleet RIDE to identify future career possibilities based on current ASVAB score. Consider retaking ASVAB. Meet routinely with Mentor and CCC to discuss your career opportunities and progression.

## 24-15 months prior to SEAOS/ PRD

Approaching End of SEAOS

Soft End of Active Obligated Service (SEAOS) equals EAOS plus any extensions. Command conducts CDB to verify you are on track for Fleet RIDE/PTS approval. Know your Year Group. Consider options for future rating conversion.

## 15-12 months prior to SEAOS/ PRD

Fleet RIDE/PTS application window.

Qualify for PTS using Fleet RIDE. Submit applications based on career options and goals:  
Apply to Reenlist INRATE  
Apply to Reenlist INRATE, but are willing to Convert  
Apply for Conversion ONLY  
Apply for SELRES Option (submit application for SELRES any time within your 15-3 month window.  
Apply for Separation from the Navy at EAOS/SEAOS

## 12-6 months prior to SEAOS/ PRD

Fleet RIDE/PTS processing window.

Communicate with your CCC to obtain monthly results and to update your PTS application based on application results:  
APPROVED: You are approved for reenlistment INRATE or for Conversion to a new rating.  
DENIED: You are within 12-7 months of SEAOS, are denied a quota this month, but can continue to submit applications.  
DENIED-Final Active: You are within 6-0 months of SEAOS, are denied a quota, and can no longer submit an application for reenlistment as an Active Duty Sailor. Consider submitting for Selected Reserve (SELRES).  
Attend the Navy Transition Assistance Program (TAP).

## 10-6 months prior to SEAOS/ PRD

9-7 months prior to PRD  
(Orders negotiation window)

If not selected for INRATE approval, consider updating application to "Apply for INRATE and willing to Convert" or "Conversion ONLY".  
Command will conduct CDB and use FleetRIDE to review your conversion options.

## 6 months prior to SEAOS

Final Fleet RIDE/PTS determination.

You must have Fleet RIDE/PTS approval PRIOR to submitting a CMS/ID job application.

## 5-3 months prior to SEAOS

## SEAOS

Consider submitting an application for Selected Reserve (SELRES).  
Attend the Navy Transition Assistance Program (TAP), if you haven't already attended.

If you do not receive a PTS quota OR if you have no desire to remain on Active Duty, submit an application for Selected Reserve (SELRES).

Available Fleet RIDE/PTS quotas change every month, based on needs of the Navy. It is VERY important that you closely monitor quota availability. Your CCC will help you obtain and review monthly quotas in Fleet RIDE/PTS.

Anytime you have a question about your Fleet RIDE/PTS you should request a CDB with your Chain of Command.
