Navy Operational Support Centers (NOSC) WiFi: 126 sites live and four sites scheduled for installation next week. Sites going live since last report are NOSC Columbia, VR 59, VAW 77, and CNRIC NIRR SE Det New Orleans. Sites scheduled for installation next week are CNRIC NIRR SE Det Ft Worth TX, NOSC New Orleans, NOSC Earle, and NCHB 10. Two week projection: Finalize installation scheduling of 20 sites. Four week projection: Installation at the 20 sites in progress and all other sites in scheduling with CenturyLink. Vendor experiencing supply chain problems as Channel Service Units (CSU) are on back order, delaying installation at future sites. CNRFC is engaging directly with the vendor to mitigate impacts.
