**Latest updates**

Continuum of Service: FleetRIDE for SELRES. As of 16 July, 99.7% of all Training Unit Identification Codes (TRUICs) are covered by either a NOSC or Unit Career Counselor (CC) with a registered FleetRIDE account. All NOSC and CCs should have a FleetRIDE account within 60 days of system rollout for their TRUIC(s) if they have enlisted E6 and below inventory assigned. Total number of Sailors qualified in FleetRIDE increased by 2080 two weeks ago for a total of 6883 (19.5%) of all E6 and below.

Annual Information Assurance (IA) Awareness Training for the Navy Reserve Force is at 94% completion, OPNAV N095 (staff and embeds) at 100%. Navy Reserve directed compliance date is 31 July. Commander Navy Reserve Forces Command will deactivate Navy Marine Corps Intranet accounts for all personnel not completing the training by 31 July.
